
STETTLER FIGURE SKATING CLUB HOW TO SIGN UP FOR VOLUNTEER TASKS


- 1. Go to https://www.stettlerskatingclub.com/
- 2. Sign into your account click LOGIN at the top right corner of the site
- 3. Click on REGISTRATION, then click on ADD VOLUNTEER POSITION




4. Review the volunteer positions in the list. Click SELECT for the position(s) you want to sign up for.



VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS:

- All families with skaters in CanSkate, JumpStart, Junior Star or StarSkate are required to provide SFSC with a \$250 volunteer cheque dated March 31, 2024, PRIOR to their skater beginning lessons. The volunteer cheque will not be cashed if volunteer hours are completed. If volunteer requirements are not completed, the volunteer cheque will be cashed on March 31, 2024.
- Volunteer Hours Required:
 - Part Time CanSkate 5 hours per family
 - Full Time CanSkate, JumpStart, Junior Star, & StarSkate 8 hours per family
 - o PreCanSkate, Adult Synchro and Fall Session Junior Star families no volunteer requirements
 - Families with a skater participating in our FunSkate are asked to complete one FunSkate related volunteer task.
 - o Families with a skater participating in Carnival are asked to complete one Carnival related volunteer task.
- Families should complete a Volunteer Log to document their volunteer hours and submit it to the Volunteer Liaison (Kyla Arden) or any Board Member before March 31, 2024. Volunteer logs can be found on the website.
