There is not a time allotted to the required FunSkate or Carnival task, but it must be completed in entirety and signed off by the relevant committee member or board member. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> If you have a skater in CanSkate, JumpStart, Junior Star or StarSkate, families are required to submit a \$250.00 volunteer cheque before your skater steps on the ice. Post-date volunteer cheques to March 31, 2024. If skater withdraws after the refund deadline (21 days after program start date or 21 days after first day of skating if late registration), volunteer hours must still be fulfilled. Late registrants must complete full volunteer hours. If a family does not fulfill volunteer hours, cheque will be cashed March 31st. It is the skating family's responsibility to ensure that their Volunteer Log is submitted. Skating families will not be contacted to provide their Volunteer Log.
